- CVCH built their screening tools into Athena
- Coordinated Care 100% screened through the enrollment call center, built upon other evidence based tools
- FHC through Athena, educating the call center staff to capture organic information like cancelling appt. for transportation.
- CVCH agreement with Link to provide transportation to and from the clinic – est. 20% of patients are missing or are late to appointments
- Catholic Charities has two programs that support interventions for SDOH. Diversion Program True Blood and new HARPs Program. Financial support for housing, food insecurity and other interventions.
