Completed Meetings

Two Fully-Integrated Medicaid Contracting Advisory Committee meetings were held in April. The details of those meetings are below:

Takeaways:

- There are three committees that are contracted and managed by the BHO: Family Youth System Partnership Roundtable (FYSPRT), Behavioral Health Advisory Board, Children's Long-term Inpatient Program (CLIP). By January 1, 2018, these committees will need to be managed by a different organization. Each committee comes with some funding to support the work.
- Options include a community organization, the Administrative Service Organization (ASO), provider agency, jointly by MCOs and ASO, the Accountable Community of Health.
- North Central ACH does not want to manage these committees – NC ACH wants to push capacity into the community to ensure long-term sustainability.

Takeaways:

- North Central ACH is responsible for creating an Early Warning System with the primary purpose of indentifying gaps in care and providers who are not receiving timely payments during the first 6-12 months of fully-integrated Medicaid Contracting.
- SWWA implemented an early Warning System that we can use as a starting point to develop NC ACH's. Some lessons learned from SWWA:
 - Start early and collect baseline data if possible/necessary
 - Krista Concannon from the AIM (Analytics, Interoperability and Measurement) team will assist in collecting/analyzing data
 - EWS system is not just metrics, it is also rapid resolution phone calls in early weeks

HCA Request for Proposals

- MCO RFP
 - HCA has posted the response to questions about the MCO RFP (March 22nd)
 - Proposals from MCOs are due by April 5th
 - The scoring period will run from April 6th - May 5th
 - Apparently successful bidders will be announced on or around May 11th
- ASO RFP
 - ASO RFP is has be released (March 15th)
 - ASO bidders have 60 days to respond
 - 30 days to scoring period
 - Apparently successful bidder will be announced around June 15th
