Completed Meetings

One Fully-Integrated Medicaid Contracting Advisory Committee meeting was held in April. The details of that meeting are below:

Workgroups of the Advisory Committee

Early Warning System

The Early Warning System (EWS) workgroup met twice in April (14th, 28th). We are in the process of identifying indicators and delegating who will be responsible for reporting that data. A draft indicator matrix has been developed that will continue to evolve during this process. The target date for the EWS to be operational is July 1, 2017 in order to collect 6 months of baseline data.

Managed Care Rates

The Managed Care Rates workgroup met twice in April (14th, 28th). Millimen has developed a tool for providers to use to supply data that is potentially not accounted for in the current rates. The BH providers in the workgroup have agreed to complete the information by May 12th. Millimen will then review the data by the next meeting which is May 17th. Millimen will review the prevalence of serious mental illness and incidence of crisis services NCW compared to other regions.

IT/EHR

The IT/EHR workgroup met on April 13th which involved a discussion of current work by providers, the BHO, and Qualis. Currently, only one provider is planning to continue using Avatar on January 1, 2018. The next meeting is scheduled for May 24th at which time the Behavioral health IT assessments will be completed and available for review and the MCOs will have been selects.

Consumer Engagement

The Consumer Engagement workgroup met on April 14th. A list of potential audiences was developed (ie. providers, community health workers, navigators). A timeline of all communications by MCO plans (old and new), BHO, and HCA will be developed which will aid in determining where the gaps are in the communication process and appropriate timing of communications by the Advisory Committee should attempt fill.
