Discussion topics:

- Discussion occurred on new RSA Map and transitional state of Okanogan County which opted out of NC BHO for 2016.
- Barry had conversation w Chase regarding poor communication about the new RSA map. Unfortunately it was not run through the ACH prior to going public. Most communication happen with commissioners who were in the loop.
- Okanogan Co. representation on the NCACH Board: Discussion on possibilities occurred. Effort should be made to assure two Okanogan reps on board. Some options are:

 - o Creating another seat for Primary Care physician from OK county.
 - o It should be someone that OK recognizes as credible and well networked.
