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Chelan-Douglas Coalition for Health Improvement to host employment and transportation community forum on October 10th

The Chelan-Douglas Coalition for Health Improvement (CHI) invites you to join them for a community forum identifying solutions to employment-related transportation barriers in Chelan and Douglas Counties at their event, Chelan-Douglas Rides to Work: An Employment and Transportation Forum on Wednesday, October 10th.

The event is for job-seekers, workers, employers, care coordinators, transportation providers, and service agencies in Chelan and Douglas Counties who have experienced difficulty accessing transportation for employment. The Chelan-Douglas CHI is working to build a healthier North Central Washington by addressing things that affect health outside of the clinic such as access to employment, transportation, housing, nutrition, and community programs. The CHI has recently identified a large gap in programs and resources available to support those who are working (or seeking work) in Chelan and Douglas Counties, which is how the Forum came to be.

"It's an important opportunity to come together and to engage all current and prospective partners in Chelan and Douglas Counties in this conversation," said Tanya Gleason, Capacity Development and Grant Manager at North Central Accountable Community of Health, as well as a Chelan-Douglas CHI member.

The Forum is free to attend and is open to anyone living, working, or commuting in Chelan and Douglas Counties.
