<b>Do you know of funding opportunities that could help support these projects?</b>
Department of Health CDC funding for healthy communities
Beacon Health- funding for behavioral health that is non-medicaid
Medicaid billable service
Planned Parenthood: Other telehealth services available- collaborating with other organizations to provide necessary services
Community Foundation of North Central Washington. Are there funds for economic development, to help build/maintain the infrastructure?
Community Action Council - Essential Pantry
Group Health Foundation, church endowments, grants from local churches.
Food Pantry- connect with WVC
Cashmere Market- WVC have some produce projects
Community Foundation - least restrictive funding and reporting
Planned Parenthood - how does this fit into medicaid transformation and integrated bh and primary care
End of year giving campaigns

<b>In what ways could these projects be supported?</b>
<b>At the individual level:</b>
donations (time, monetary, supplies, etc.)
Volunteer opportunities-their “need/want/desire” to help their communities and capitalize on that.
Drop of donations at little essential pantries, Attend Cashmere Market post it on social media
Show up!
Certainly by financial support, donations and word of mouth or volunteering.
<b>At the organization level:</b>
hosting donation drives, make a difference day group activity
What kind of support are they asking for, or do they need?
Talk about the projects at work with staff, donation projects
Be part of the market with a free nonprofit booth
Planning for services to be located within easy walking distance of a bus stop and Link provide planning around some of these services e.g. essential services like food.
Link would be interested in knowing where all of the little pantry locations are located so they could look at there transportation routes to see if they have bus stops close by.
Think about locating little pantries close to bus stops.
Transportation services to Public Markets.
Early Learning Coalition. Help Me Grow project talk about extension of diaper banks in partnership with little pantries organization.
<b>At the coalition level:</b>

awareness, sharing of resources/ communication among members, outreach to the general public (newspaper, radio, social media)

IRIS - community success and stories, advocate for NCACH funding support, being the convener and connector to other agencies, host a community food drive, Market Sponsorships, Stuff the bus type of events

Maybe have a CHI day where members get a sticker or something cool

May host a conversation about diaper banks, how to set up and fund.
