Data Resources for Pilot and Design Regions April 9. 2015

The following is a draft matrix of data resources offering menu driven analysis or summary statistics which can be used for needs assessment, project prioritization and program planning. Most of the identified resources allow analysis by pilot and design regions. Those resources not yet available by pilot and design regions can be analyzed by county or other sub-state geography. Many of these resources are available publicly, and when not public, are available to local health jurisdiction assessment coordinators. Many local health jurisdictions already have community health assessments or have worked with hospital partners on community health needs assessments. They are a great resource to contact when working on regional needs assessments, prioritizations and planning. A list of local health assessment coordinators is available here.
