Substance Abuse Block Grant (SABG)

Funding FY17: \$567,344

- Requires submission of a project plan; plan must be approved by BH Advisory Board
- Could fund: OP Services for OST, Naloxone, UA's

Criminal Justice Treatment Account (CJTA)

Funding FY17: \$210,000

- Must follow RCW 70.96A.350
- Requires submission of CJTA plan to DBHR and approval of plan by regional CJTA panel.
- Thirty percent must be spent on an "innovative project"
- Biennium Allocation
- Funding can only be used to support services to offenders

Dedicated Marijuana Account (DMA)

Funding FY17: \$87,000

- DMA funds shall be used to fund substance use disorder treatment services for youth living at or below 220% of the federal poverty level, without insurance coverage or who are seeking services independent of their parent/guardian.
- DMA funds may be used for development, implementation, maintenance, and evaluation of programs that support intervention, treatment, and recovery support services for middle school and high school aged students.
- All new programs services must direct at least eighty-five percent (85%) of funding to evidence- based or research-based programs and practices that produce objectively measurable results, and are expected to be cost beneficial.
- Up to fifteen percent (15%) of the funds appropriated for new programs and new services may be used to provide support to proven and tested practices, emerging best practices, or promising practices.
